1. GENERAL INFORMATION

This Nordic Judges & Officials Seminar 2007 is to be held at the Stockholm International Fair during the final weekend of the Stockholm International Boatshow which is the largest annual public event in Sweden and the oldest boatshow in the world. The boatshow was visited by 110 000 visitors in 2005 and will be held for the 73rd time in 2007. For the third year in a row there will be an Extreme Corner with focus on wakeskating and wakeboarding.

The seminar is targeting everyone above 18 years of age with an interest in judging wakeboard and wakeskate at a national level, or function as an official at competitions. All participants should have a basic knowledge of the sport. Participants aiming at becoming National Level 2 judges (see below) should be able to call tricks by their name and how they are executed. All participants need to be member of his or her national federation.

Instructors will be Claes Scheffer, Niclas Dahlgren and Robert Gustavsson, with International wakeboard and wakeskate judges as well as national calculators.

The seminar agenda is subject to change. One session will be dedicated to wakeskating, and one will be dedicated to the calculation program and the heat system.

3. EXAMINATION

Participants will be able to get examined as National Level 3 and National Level 2 wakeboard and wakeskate judges but not as calculators. All examinations are conducted during Sunday. All participants are encouraged to take part in the whole seminar. National Level 3 judges are examined through a written examination with an 80% pass mark. National Level 2 judges are examined through the same written examination with an 80% pass mark as well as through a practical examination using video.

3.1 Levels

International Level 1 – International Level 1 judges are international judges and qualified to judge at European and World Championships.

International Level 2 / National Level 1 – International Level 2 judges are also National Level 1 judges, function as national chief judges, and are qualified to judge at national competitions and European competitions.

National Level 2 – National Level 2 judges are national judges and are qualified to judge at national competitions.

National Level 3 – National Level 3 judges are assistant judges and are qualified to officiate at national competitions.

4. TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

4.1 Travel

The closest airport is Arlanda Airport in Stockholm. It is also possible to fly to Skavsta Airport to where some budget airlines arrive, but the transfer will take somewhat longer.

From Arlanda the easiest way to get to the Stockholm International Fair and the First Hotel Royal Star is to take either the airport coach or Arlanda Express to the Stockholm Central Station.

From The Stockholm Central Station it takes 9 minutes by train to Älvsjö where the Stockholm International Fair and the First Hotel Royal Star is located.
